About Pledging at Bethesda

What is a "pledge?"

A pledge is a commitment to give a certain amount of money throughout the year to help this community sustain and grow.

Why does my pledge mean so much to Bethesda?

Bethesda depends almost exclusively on pledges and donations (70%) to fund and fulfill our mission. Your pledge to Bethesda says, "I am part of this community, and I want to show that this parish and its values are important to me."

How do I decide how much to pledge to Bethesda?

Your giving is as personal as your prayer life, and only you can know what is right for you at this stage of your journey. The important thing is to make a heartfelt commitment. You'll find that as Bethesda grows, you are growing too.

How do I pledge?

We ask you to tell us about your pledge by completing a pledge card or pledging online at bbts.org/giving/. Weekly offering envelopes are made available soon after pledges are received.

What if my circumstances change?

The good news is that we can absolutely do this, with your help!


TARGET GOAL: \$3 million (last year's goal: \$2.5 million)

Target Number of Pledges: 400 (last year's total: 345)




By the Numbers
